

Chippewa Valley Schools - SUMMER SCHOOL 2024



HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT RECOVERY COURSES

Summer School will be held remotely this year. Students will register through the Community Education link below. Students may register for up to three 0.5 credit courses. Students will be completing the entire course at a location of their choosing. School computer labs will not be open to summer school students.

NOTE: Students will be working independently, with the support of a certified CVS teacher. In-district 9th – 11th grade students will have access to their school laptop over the summer. in-coming freshmen and current seniors will be able to borrow a laptop from the district IT Department. Out-of-district students must provide their own computer. Classes begin on Monday, June 24 and close on Thursday, August 8. Late registrations and drop requests close on Thursday, June 27. The district will be closed July 1-5 and summer school teachers will not be available. Students will have full access to their course(s) and may choose to work ahead.

Neither registration nor payment for a summer school course guarantee a passing grade or credit toward graduation requirements. It is highly recommended that students and parents consult their high school counselor before registering for courses.

<u>All courses will earn a letter grade.</u> To pass a course, students must complete 100% of all course activities with an overall grade of 60% or higher. Course grades will be reported to counselors in late August when they return to prepare for the new school year.

HOW DO I REGISTER?

- There is a cost for each semester course. Charges of \$195.00 –one class (0.5 credit) / \$390.00 two classes (1 credit) / \$585.00 three classes (1.5 credits) for all students.
- REGISTRATION and PAYMENT DEADLINE: JUNE 20, 2024

REPORT CARDS-SCHOOL COPY

Grade reports will be sent to each student's home school. Students should advise their counselors when they meet in the Fall Semester that they took classes in Summer School.

CHECKLIST:

- Classes begin June 24, 2024 and conclude on August 8, 2024
- Course access information and program orientation will be emailed to students and parents by 8am on Monday, June 24.
- Tuition is \$195.00 per 0.5 credit for all students. Students are limited to a maximum of three summer school courses.
- Registration and payment must be completed no later than June 27, 2024.
