### Enrichment

- **Book Fair** – total sales \$9,960; profit \$4,500 in Scholastic Dollars. Cash would have been less, may consider cash payout in 2024-25.
  - We currently have over \$8,100 Scholastic Dollars. Are using for some Carnival and Read A Thon prizes, plan to use some for Teacher Appreciation.
